PACKING LIST

PERSONAL ITEMS

- Bedding/Linens
 - ★ Twin-sized air mattress, cot, or foam pad
 - ★ Sleeping bag or sheets
 - ★ Pillow & blanket
 - ★ Towels for showering
- o Toiletries (Girls, be sure to pack feminine hygiene products just in case)
- Medications you need for the week (have labeled in a bag with instructions to turn in to trip leaders upon arrival at Westwood)
- Plastic Trash bag to collect your dirty clothing
- o Bug spray & Sunscreen
- Water bottle
- Bible
- Pen/Pencil for program and devotions

CLOTHING

- Modest swimsuit and shower shoes (for locker room showering)
- o Pajamas, socks & underwear
- Casual Clothes & Work Clothes:
 - ★ Work shoes (must have closed-toed shoes!)
 - ★ Please make sure all clothing is modest and appropriate. Tank tops and cut offs are not allowed at the worksites think t-shirts! Worksite shorts must be longer length (no shorty shorts!). Yoga pants or capris are okay, but it might be hot!). Some sites may have us paint or clean, so make sure these clothes can get dirty! No dangling jewelry is allowed at worksites.
 - ★ Bring at least one pair of pants or capris as some worksites will require them
 - ★ Work gloves
 - ★ Hat, sunglasses or bandana if you wish
 - **★** Sweatshirt or Jacket

OPTIONAL:

- Flashlight
- Camera (NOT your cell phone)
- Small mirror
- Snacks (for the bus ride or while we're there)
- o Rain gear

- Fun items for theme dinners: Christmas Monday, Wacky Wednesday, Tropical Thursday
- o Spending money (for snacks, souvenirs, t-shirts, etc.)
- o Cards, Games, Frisbees, volleyballs, footballs, etc. if you want them for free time
- Gifts to bless some of the community partners in Kenosha: They have asked for kids board games and blankets

DON'T BRING THE FOLLOWING

- o **ELECTRONICS**: iPods/iPads/Kindles, etc.
- Cell Phones! We try very hard to allow students the opportunity to be fully-present at the event, and part of that includes 'unplugging' from outside distractions. We also would like to not have to worry about electronics being lost or stolen while we're away. (Students can be reached via Aaron's cell or they can use a leaders' phone in case of an emergency)
